MONDAY

Soccer

3:45–4:30 p.m.

Instructor: SocRoc

Grade Level: Preschool 2-4's

Maximum # of students: 12

Spanish (K & Up)

Grade Level: K-G6

Maximum # of students: 9

This course is introducing new words and phrases through a variety of games and activities. It is open to both new students as well as students who are continuing on from Summer camp. In this course, emphasis is placed on discovering the joy of learning another language while setting the foundation for future studies in Spanish. Students practice speaking, listening, reading, and writing in Spanish. Subjects are taught in a way that is fun, dynamic, and educational and incorporate activities for every style of learning (kinesthetic, visual, and auditory).

WEDNESDAY

Robots & Chemistry

3:15–4:00 p.m.

Instructor: NOR Y

Grade Level: 3-5's

Maximum # of students: 12

In NOR Y Robots & Chemistry, we teach students "why" then "what" to help them become more inquisitive and to show them how to look at the world differently. Through hands-on experiments and collaborative projects, our class not only builds a foundational understanding of robotics and chemistry but also a love of each at an early age. The class covers such topics as: learning to code through off-screen robotics, then switches gears to making simple circuits and robotic projects. Along the way, kids learn about the Scientific Method using a controlled variable and study the concepts of elasticity and viscosity. Families receive a weekly recap note, that highlight key learning points, to help keep track of how their innovators are progressing.

Chess 1

3:15–4:15 p.m.

Instructor: Growing Minds

Grade Level: K&G1

Maximum # of students: 6

This class will introduce (and/or review) piece movement, familiarize or solidify all of the basic chess rules, introduce chess notation and coordinates, help students learn how to build and execute a plan for different parts of the game, and learn how to build a strategic foundation. This class is recommended for students who either are entirely new to chess or have had limited experience, and want to build upon their introduction before they are ready for the more advanced classes.

Chess 2

4:30–5:30 p.m.

Instructor: Growing Minds

Grade Level: G2-G6

Maximum # of students: 6

This class is recommended for students who have mastered piece movement and captures, understand the basic rules, and are interested in building upon this foundation. Students will explore basic tactics and strategy, and be introduced to the different parts of the game. We also will introduce chess notation, which teaches students to understand and use chessboard coordinates, while recording their moves. Students will learn how to build and execute plans for different parts of the game. We will cover the basic rules embraced at most local chess tournaments, and introduce related topics such as good sportsmanship – students in this class often will play in Novice sections. Students will be assessed in their first week to determine their ability within each section.

THURSDAY

Ballet

Grade Level: Preschool 2-4's

Maximum # of students: 8

Ballet focuses on the foundations of proper body alignment, technique, and vocabulary. In this class dancers develop flexibility, coordination, and confidence.

Policies and Procedures

AFTER-SCHOOL PROCEDURES

Our teachers will escorted after-school students to their room. They will have time to have snacks. The after-school instructors will meet the students in the classroom. Pick up will take place in the class location at dismissal.

Please make sure the after-school students will b pickled up on time. For those who are not picked up after the end of class, we'll place them at extended care room and charge \$20/day for the service.

ABSENCES

If a student misses an after-school class due to illness or schedule conflicts, we cannot offer a make-up class. If an after-school class will be canceled due to the absence of instructor or weather, we will offer a makeup at the end of the sessions.

REGISTRATION

Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis. The signup link will be send to parents by email. After 1 week of registration, you will receive a confirmation if the class will open. If a requested class is filled or canceled, you will be notified via email as well. No drop-in options for enrichment classes, and students must register for the entire semester.

DROPPING CLASSES/ REFUNDS

Family can receive 100% refund before the first session and 75% refund after the first class. NO REFUNDS after the second class. **There are no exceptions to this policy; please be familiar with the policy before registering your child for the classes.**
